Award Name	Amount	Description
Bedford Grange Mutual Scholarship	Dependent on the number of qualified students. Last year's awards were \$1,400 each.	Provides awards to children of Bedford Grange Mutual Insurance company policy-holders. The application is open to high school seniors who plan to attend a college, university, or trade/technical school in the fall, as well as collegiate freshmen, sophomores, and juniors. Applicants must show a strong history of community service and extra-curricular involvement, and demonstrate that they are motivated to achieve their goals.
Cambria County HWC Scholarship	\$1,000	Are you a person who loves to help people? If so, this is the right scholarship for you. The Cambria County HWC Scholarship provides scholarship support for an individual residing in Cambria County who has been accepted to attend a post-secondary institution in Cambria County with the goal of receiving a certificate, associate's degree, or bachelor's degree and plans to enter into a human service field after graduation. This is open to both high school seniors and non-traditional students. Eligible schools are: Greater Johnstown Career and Technology Center, Mount Aloysius College, Penn Highlands Community College, St. Francis University, and University of Pittsburgh at Johnstown.
Children are Precious Fund - Johnstown Walk of Hope Scholarship	Fund rep decides annually	Provides scholarships for students who have a cancer diagnosis or are a cancer survivor or who have been impacted by a cancer diagnosis of a parent or caregiver.
Conemaugh Valley Culinary Association Robert Forquer Memorial Scholarship	\$500	This scholarship was created to award students from Cambria County who have exceptional promise, financial need, and are planning to study culinary arts at an accredited post-secondary school.
Eastern Elevator-Irene Westover Memorial Scholarship	\$2,500 each	The Eastern Elevator Irene Westover Memorial Scholarship Fund is named in honor of Eastern Elevator's Founding Mother, Irene Westover. Irene was forced to end her education at the age of 11 or 12 to help her mother raise her younger siblings upon the accidental death of her father. Irene proceeded to raise eight children whom she nurtured through their educational years. This scholarship is available to relatives of full-time Eastern Elevator employees who wish to continue their education. Eligible applicants must be accepted into a post-secondary program and will attend a two- or four-year accredited institution of higher learning or a recognized and accredited trade school. Students may be traditional or non-traditional, full- or part-time, and be in any year of their education progress.

<p>Indiana County Fire Chiefs Association Student Scholarship Award</p>	<p>2 @ \$500 each</p>	<p>This scholarship was created to recognize and support students for community service. It is open to high school seniors or graduates pursuing post-secondary education at an accredited college or university, business, or trade school. Collegiate freshman, sophomores, and juniors are eligible to apply, as well as non-traditional students who will be re-entering school in the upcoming semester. Students must live within the service area of an Indiana County Fire Department.</p>
<p>Jeff Dull Memorial Scholarship</p>	<p>Donor decides annually. Last year's awards were \$1,000 each.</p>	<p>This scholarship supports a graduating student enrolled at Bedford County Technical Center. If the student is pursuing post-secondary education the award will be distributed to the school of that student's choice. If the student is not continuing their education, the award will be given as a cash award paid directly to the student. BCTC has applications available, and works with the family to make their award selections annually.</p>
<p>Johnstown Tomahawks College Student Scholarship</p>	<p>\$1,000</p>	<p>The Johnstown Tomahawks Foundation will award one scholarship to a local college student. The scholarship awarded will be \$1,000.</p> <p>REQUIREMENTS FOR ELIGIBILITY: Must be attending a post-secondary institution located in Cambria, Bedford, Blair, Westmoreland, Indiana, or Somerset County. Winner must show proof of enrollment for the fall of 2023 at an institution located within those counties.</p>
<p>John B. Lowman Scholarship</p>	<p>Significant award amount, typically a few thousand per student</p>	<p>The John B. Lowman Scholarship, established by the will of Dr. John B. Lowman, a surgeon who died in 1953, states that scholarships will be awarded to students who reside in Cambria County and who have been accepted to a recognized medical school for physicians.</p>
<p>Herald and Jane (Rummel) Griffith Memorial Maple Spring College Scholarship</p>	<p>\$1,000</p>	<p>This scholarship provides a \$1,000.00 award for a qualified candidate who must be either a member of the active congregation at Maple Spring Church, or the children, grandchildren, and other family members of the congregation, as screened and qualified by the church finance committee. Eligible students will be graduating from high school this academic year and planning to attend a post-secondary institution after graduation.</p>

<p>Larry R. Mastrine Memorial Scholarship</p>	<p>Maximum award amount of \$30,000 to be paid out over four years</p>	<p>Dr. Larry Mastrine was a competent, dedicated, and well-loved physician in his community for over 40 years. He believed in the value of education and hard work, and he treated his patients and everyone he knew with kindness. Dr. Mastrine grew up in the small town of Colver, studied in Pittsburgh, and returned to raise his family in the community that was a source of pride for him. His patients became friends and he worked tirelessly to solve their medical issues and to encourage them during illness and tough times. Sadly, Dr. Mastrine passed away in January 2021. The Mastrine family, inspired by Dr. Mastrine's commitment to and impact on his community, has established a scholarship fund in Dr. Mastrine's memory that will allow local college eligible young adults with financial constraints an opportunity to complete college and begin satisfying careers.</p> <p>This Larry R. Mastrine Memorial Scholarship is available to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • High school juniors and seniors, as well as freshmen community college students • Who have attended or are attending a high school in Cambria County or Windber High School • Who are pursuing or plan to pursue a 4-year degree • Who have financial need <p>Award amounts will vary based on the financial need of the student with a maximum amount of \$30,000 paid out up to four years, so long as the student is making satisfactory progress towards graduation.</p>
<p>McCready Family Scholarship</p>	<p>\$2,600</p>	<p>Provides a scholarship award to a high school graduate from Cambria, Somerset, or Bedford County who plans to pursue an academic degree relating to communications, journalism, or English at the University of Pittsburgh at Johnstown.</p>
<p>Pride of Somerset County Scholarship</p>	<p>\$1,000</p>	<p>Pride of Somerset County provides support for programs that work to provide resources for and education about the LGBTQ+ population within Somerset and the surrounding counties. Their scholarship awards \$1,000 to a graduating senior who plans to attend a post-secondary school for Gender Studies, LGBTQ affairs or practices, or Behavioral Health, and who has financial need. Students from Cambria, Somerset, Bedford and Blair Counties are eligible to apply.</p>

Side by Side Humanitarian Award	Two \$5,000 awards annually	<p>The Side by Side Humanitarian Award, provided through the LivRed Foundation, was established to recognize outstanding individuals who dedicate their time to fighting indifference, intolerance, and injustice. Ideal applicants must meet the following criteria:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Must either be a graduating senior of, or a past graduate of Ferndale or Conemaugh Valley High School, or Seminole High School • Attending any post-secondary school • Must be a volunteer or employed person, who goes above and beyond their duties to improve the lives of others, and serve the community as a model or mentor • Fundraiser or charitable contributor that supports youth/senior programs, animal interests, or other local nonprofit organization • Demonstrates random acts of kindness <p>This award is given in memory of Olivia Catherine Red. Olivia walked into a room and the light came on. Her glow put the sun to shame. She was the first one to pick you up and make you smile when you were down. She was a champion of the underdog, she was good to people, funny, loyal, and more than anything she was kind. The recipient of the Side by Side Humanitarian Award is that special person who wakes up every morning and puts others before themselves, and dedicates their life to helping others in need.</p>
Tika Hetrick, Cory Roadman, and Tucker, Memorial Scholarship	\$500	This scholarship awards students who worked at Hickory Hollow Campground or Haunted Hollow, in memory of Tika Hetrick, Cory Roadman and Tucker, beloved members of the Hickory Hollow and Haunted Hollow team. It is available to graduating seniors and nontraditional students so long as they're pursuing post-secondary education.
William R. Lloyd, Jr. Scholarship	\$3,000	This scholarship award supports students of Somerset County public high schools who intend to major in Government, Political Science, or Politics. The award has been endowed by former State Representative Bill Lloyd (D-Somerset) to encourage Somerset County students to pursue careers in public service. The scholarship will be paid out in the winner's sophomore year of college and is renewable for their junior and senior years if certain eligibility requirements are met.
YWCA Karen Kleinosky Scholarship	2 at \$500 each	Provides scholarship support for female students who have attended a high school located in Cambria or Somerset counties.

George F. Wheeling Scholarship	Amount varies	<p>The George F. Wheeling Scholarship was created to provide scholarships to deserving students with an above average academic record who have excelled in their area of interest and demonstrate financial need. This scholarship is only awarded to students who are attending colleges that plan to match the scholarship amount awarded.</p> <p>Requirements: The scholarship is available to senior high school students who plan to attend an accredited four-year institution in the fall, and is also available to collegiate freshmen, sophomore and junior students attending an accredited four-year institution. Eligible students must have at least a 500 score on both Math and Verbal SAT and be in the top 20 percent of their graduating class. Eligible students must be accepted into or planning to attend Indiana University of Pennsylvania, University of Pittsburgh at Johnstown, or St. Francis University. Further, all applicants must be in financial need.</p> <p>This is an online application and will be available at cfalleghenies.org/scholarships in the Spring.</p>
Richland Township Volunteer Fire Department Live-In Scholarship	Amount varies	<p>The Richland Township Volunteer Fire Department is the busiest volunteer department in Cambria & Somerset Counties. We provide service throughout a very large region including much of the Johnstown MSA; Westmont, Upper Yoder, Ferndale, Riverside, Adams Township, and as far away as Davidsville and Boswell outside of the immediate area.</p> <p>As a recognized Rapid Intervention Team (RIT) we are dispatched on many regional departments' initial response to reported structure fires. We also provide that RIT service to the City of Johnstown many times each year when they have a working structure fire.</p> <p>To provide the highest level and most rapid service to the people we serve, the RTFD relies on our "Live-In Program" to provide critical staffing needs, particularly in the overnight hours. We are offering scholarship opportunities to trained post-secondary students to live at our fire station on Scalp Ave. We have accommodations for up to 8 such members.
