Award Name	Amount	Description
Bailey Family Football Matters Scholarship	\$500	Provides scholarship support to a senior student who is currently enrolled in a Southern Alleghenies Football Coaches Association school and is a member of their high school football team.
Baskin Foundation Scholarship	Fund rep decides annually	The Baskin Foundation was designed to award scholarships for higher education to students who have attended a high school located in Indiana County and are planning to pursue a degree in nursing or physical education and have a demonstrated history of academic achievement. The foundation was created in 1996 in memory of Anna Mae Sweeny Baskin and Graham Sefton Baskin.
Elmer C. Laslo Memorial Scholarship	\$1,000	Provides scholarship support for students pursuing a business-related field at a post-secondary educational institution. Eligible applicants must attend a high school located within the 1st Summit Bank market area.
Indiana County Fire Chiefs Association Student Scholarship Award	2 @ \$500 each	This scholarship was created to recognize and support students for community service. It is open to high school seniors or graduates pursuing post-secondary education at an accredited college or university, business, or trade school. Collegiate freshman, sophomores, and juniors are eligible to apply, as well as non-traditional students who will be re-entering school in the upcoming semester. Students must live within the service area of an Indiana County Fire Department.
Mr. Jodon Educational Scholarship	\$500	Provides a scholarship for students in Bedford, Cambria, Indiana, Somerset, or Westmoreland counties who will be pursuing a post-secondary degree in education.
Scott A. Salsler Memorial Scholarship	\$500	Provides an annual scholarship to a student who lives in Indiana County who is planning to study at the post-secondary level in fields related to music and vocal performance, including education.

Diana Lynn Holben Scholarship	\$2,500 (providing the donor provides a donation for this year’s award)	Supports a graduating senior from Homer-Center School District and provides encouragement for them to pursue personal growth through post-secondary education, with strong consideration given to an individual who has experienced discouraging life challenges that may be influencing their faith, courage or motivation.
Isaac Kelly “Built Different” Scholarship	\$2,000	This scholarship was created to provide support for senior students at Homer-Center High School who have participated in varsity track and are pursuing post-secondary education, with preference given to students going into an arts-related field.
Kai Paul Hrabovsky Memorial Scholarship Fund	2 @ \$500 each	This scholarship was created to award two graduating seniors at Homer-Center School District who are members of at least one school sport program and members in good standing in the National Honor Society. Paper application already provided to school. Donor will participate in selection with school district.
Tom “Coach” Dixson Scholarship	2 @ \$500 each	This scholarship was created to provide support for graduating senior student athletes at Homer Center High School who display good sportsmanship. Each year two awards will be distributed, one to a male student and one to a female student.
