Award Name	Amount	Description
Bailey Family Football Matters Scholarship	\$500	Provides scholarship support to a senior student who is currently enrolled in a Southern Alleghenies Football Coaches Association school and is a member of their high school football team.
Baskin Foundation Scholarship	Fund rep decides annually	The Baskin Foundation was designed to award scholarships for higher education to students who have attended a high school located in Indiana County and are planning to pursue a degree in nursing or physical education and have a demonstrated history of academic achievement. The foundation was created in 1996 in memory of Anna Mae Sweeny Baskin and Graham Sefton Baskin.
Brush Valley Antique Iron and Power Club Scholarship	\$500	This scholarship provides awards annually to recognize and support students who are active in Future Farmers of America Club. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Active and participating member of the high school chapter of Future Farmers of America at Marion Center. • Maintain 2.5 GPA. • Letter of acceptance to attend an accredited post-secondary institution. • Provide a letter of recommendation from a high school teacher or FFA advisor. • Provide current copy of high school transcript or post-secondary institution academic transcript. • Submit a 250-word essay to share how participating in FFA has influenced your choice of educational career path following high school.
Elmer C. Laslo Memorial Scholarship	\$1,000	Provides scholarship support for students pursuing a business-related field at a post-secondary educational institution. Eligible applicants must attend a high school located within the 1st Summit Bank market area.



Indiana County Fire Chiefs Association Student Scholarship Award	2 @ \$500 each	This scholarship was created to recognize and support students for community service. It is open to high school seniors or graduates pursuing post-secondary education at an accredited college or university, business, or trade school. Collegiate freshman, sophomores, and juniors are eligible to apply, as well as non-traditional students who will be re-entering school in the upcoming semester. Students must live within the service area of an Indiana County Fire Department.
Mr. Jodon Educational Scholarship	\$500	Provides a scholarship for students in Bedford, Cambria, Indiana, Somerset, or Westmoreland counties who will be pursuing a post-secondary degree in education.
Scott A. Salser Memorial Scholarship	\$500	Provides an annual scholarship to a student who lives in Indiana County who is planning to study at the post-secondary level in fields related to music and vocal performance, including education.
