WHAT IS IT?

A unique program aimed at encouraging and rewarding business-minded high school students.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

High school seniors attending Bishop McCort, Conemaugh Valley, Ferndale Area, Greater Johnstown, Richland and Westmont Hilltop school districts that have started or have a desire to start a business.

WHY SHOULD I PARTICIPATE?

Students who apply to the Strandquest-Simmons Entrepreneurship Program will be connected with local business leader mentors who will offer guidance and advice throughout the school year.

Applicants will also be able to participate in Entrepreneurial Alchemy, a community initiative that meets monthly at Pitt-Johnstown, bringing together people, ideas and money in order to initiate, facilitate and support organic economic growth in the Greater Johnstown region.

Participation in the program is also a great activity to put on your college application.

And finally – at the end of the school year, one of the program participants will be chosen to receive a \$4,000 scholarship!
