

Community Foundation for the Alleghenies 2019 Youth Philanthropy Internship



Job Description

Overview:

The Community Foundation for the Alleghenies' Youth Philanthropy Internship provides participants with an exciting summer employment opportunity in which they will identify and support solutions to problems facing our community. In turn, the Foundation expects to benefit from this program by bringing the perspectives of community youth to our grantmaking. The Foundation seeks students with an interest in community affairs, journalism, and current events.

Tasks and Responsibilities:

The interns will work to develop and implement a youth philanthropy project, which will include awarding monetary grants to a local agency (or agencies) serving the region. The interns will research issues affecting local neighborhoods, identify service priorities, develop funding guidelines, solicit requests for proposals, and award funding. The interns will receive an overview of the Foundation's approach to philanthropy and areas of giving. In addition, the interns will complete media projects related to important community issues.

- ❑ This is a summer job tentatively scheduled from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. from June 24 through August 9 (though final dates may be subject to change). **Candidates will be expected to be available for work during those dates. If you anticipate any schedule conflicts due to vacations, college orientation, etc., please let us know during the interview.**
- ❑ Interns are paid and provided with a parking pass for the duration of the internship.
- ❑ The internship headquarters will be in the Community Foundation office at 216 Franklin Street, Suite 400, in downtown Johnstown.
