Harry Henderson Cornell Scholarship	Two \$15,000 awards	<p>This opportunity is available to senior students at Blairsville High School attending any type of post-secondary education, including trade/technical schools and traditional colleges and universities. Two scholarships will be awarded each year at \$15,000 each to students meeting certain geographic requirements and demonstrating a motivation to succeed and achieve their personal goals. For both awards, students should be judged on their motivation to succeed and meet their own personal goals, not necessarily their performance in the classroom.</p> <p><b>1) A student living on the North Side of Blairsville, as described below:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a) Spring Street North of the railroad</li> <li>b) Walnut Street North of the Sulfur Run</li> <li>c) Spruce Street</li> <li>d) Hodge Street</li> <li>e) Burrell Street</li> <li>f) Chestnut Street</li> <li>g) Ranson Avenue</li> <li>h) Lear Street South of Route 22</li> </ul> <p>If no one living on the above streets qualifies, then the following can be included:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a) Maple Ave from Walnut St to the RR crossing</li> <li>b) Davis Way</li> <li>c) Decker Street</li> </ul> <p><b>2) A student living in the Borough of Blairsville.</b></p> <p>\$8,000 will be distributed directly to student's school of choice for their first year of schooling. \$4,000 will be distributed directly to school of choice for the second year of schooling, as long as student is making satisfactory progress toward graduation. Once student completes educational program, they will then be awarded the last payment of \$3,000, made payable as a cash award directly to the student.
