Everett Area Renaissance Scholarship NEW	\$500 each	Provides two scholarships to Everett Area School District Students who will be attending some type of post high school schooling. These scholarships will be awarded to students who best exemplify the attributes of the Everett Area Renaissance Foundation: academic excellence, leadership, school pride, community involvement, and significant impact on the culture of the Everett Area High School. The selection of the recipients will be the responsibility of the Everett Area High School Scholarship Committee.	
Spirit of Life Scholarship NEW	\$2,000 each	Provides two disbursements per school year. These awards are in memory of Lindy Dodson, a teacher who taught at the Everett Area School District. The selection of the recipients will be the responsibility of the Everett Area High School Scholarship Committee.	
McCready Family Scholarship Fund NEW CRITERIA	\$2,500 This scholarship is not exclusive to your students. Students from several other area school districts are eligible to apply and may be awarded the scholarship.	Provides a scholarship award to a high school graduate from Cambria, Somerset or Bedford county who plans to pursue an academic degree relating to communications, journalism, or English at the University of Pittsburgh at Johnstown. Bedford Grange Mutual Scholarship	\$1,000 awards This scholarship is not exclusive to your students. Students from other area school districts are eligible to apply and may be awarded the scholarship.	Provides awards to children of Bedford Grange Mutual Insurance Company policy-holders. The application is open to high school seniors who plan to attend a college, university, or trade/technical school in the fall, as well as collegiate freshmen, sophomores, and juniors. Applicants must show a strong history of community service and extra-curricular activity participation and demonstrate that they are motivated to achieve their future goals. Larry J. McGiboney Music Scholarship	<p>\$500</p> <p>This scholarship is not exclusive to your students. Pearl Born Scholarship	<p>\$500</p>	<p>Provides a scholarship to seniors at Everett Area High School who will be graduating and attending a post-secondary institution to major in education. Shuster Family Scholarship	<p>\$400</p>	<p>Created in honor of Bud Shuster's 70th Birthday, this scholarship is awarded to a graduating student from Everett Area High School pursuing a post-secondary education who has shown achievement in outstanding citizenship, leadership qualities, and community involvement. Recipient shall be determined by the school district committee.</p>
