<p>Beulah Harvey Memorial Scholarship</p>	<p>\$500</p>	<p>Created in memory of Beulah Harvey, a long-time Sunday School teacher who appreciated those willing to teach others, this scholarship will help fund the education of one individual who attends the Meyersdale Church of the Brethren or is approved by the scholarship committee and is enrolled in the pursuit of a degree in education.</p>	
<p>Camp PARC Helping Hand Scholarship</p>	<p>\$1,000</p> <p>This scholarship is not exclusive to your students. Doyle E. Paul Memorial Scholarship	\$1,000 This scholarship is not exclusive to your students. Students from several other area school districts are eligible to apply and may be awarded the scholarship.	Created in memory of Doyle Paul, who was devoted to promoting the agriculture Industry in Somerset County and on a state and national level. Eligible applicants must be graduating from a school district located in Somerset County and be a member of the Pennsylvania FFA Association. They also must be planning to pursue post-secondary education or training directly related to the practice of agriculture or agribusiness at an accredited post-secondary college, university or technical school in the upcoming fall semester. Frank and Bernice Lucente Community Service Scholarship	\$2,000 (\$500 a year for 4 years)	- The student will be selected for the scholarship by a committee of teachers and administrators of the Meyersdale Area High School comprised of the following: Superintendent, Principal, Curriculum Director, Guidance Counselor, Math Department Head, English Department Head and Technical Education or Vocational Department. - The student must document the type of activity participated in and have that participation verified, listing the name of the organization, the service rendered and secure the signature of the advisor. - The award will be made payable to the recipients' respective colleges over a four-year period.	
HR and Helen Konhaus Scholarship	\$1,000	The student must be a senior at the Meyersdale Area High School, and will be selected for the scholarship by a committee of teachers and administrators of the Meyersdale Area High School comprised of the Superintendent, Principal, Curriculum Director, and Heads of the English, Math and Technical Education or Vocational Departments. - Financial need is the main criterion. Interested seniors must provide a copy of their student aid report which is generated after filing the FAFSA application.	
J.L. Martin Scholarship	\$7,400 (paid out \$1,850 a year for 4 years) This scholarship is not exclusive to your students. Students from several other area school districts are eligible to apply and may be awarded the scholarship.	Supports a graduating senior of a Somerset County school district who has financial need and will likely succeed in their pursuit of post-secondary education. Your school district should provide included application to students fitting the criteria. Once all applications are submitted, school district scholarship committee should choose one top applicant. The top application, along with a recommendation letter from the school principal, should be submitted to CFA by deadline date. Applications from every school in Somerset County will be blind judged by a committee made up of at least five individuals.	April 15
Larry J. McGiboney Music Scholarship	\$500 This scholarship is not exclusive to your students.	The purpose of the fund is to provide a scholarship to at least one senior student at a local high school, with preference given to a Windber High School student, and/or a student of Pennsylvania Music Educators Association District 6, who plans to attend college with a major in music.	April 15

Atwell Memorial Music Scholarship	\$3,500	The purpose of the fund shall be to provide a variety of scholarships for music or music education majors who have graduated from Meyersdale Area High School. The scholarship will be awarded annually at graduation but shall be distributed upon completion of the awardees' fourth college semester and prior to the start of the awardees' fifth semester. The student must notify us in writing along with a copy of their grades to verify that they have completed four semesters. At that time a check will be sent to the school prior to the student starting their fifth semester.	
M. Ray Leckemby Memorial Scholarship	2 @ \$1,000 each	Provides a scholarship to one male and one female student who will be continuing their education by any post-secondary means. Winners will be chosen by the Meyersdale Area Scholarship Committee.	
McCready Family Scholarship Fund NEW CRITERIA	\$2,500 This scholarship is not exclusive to your students. Students from several other area school districts are eligible to apply and may be awarded the scholarship.	Provides a scholarship award to a high school graduate from Cambria, Somerset or Bedford county who plans to pursue an academic degree relating to communications, journalism, or English at the University of Pittsburgh at Johnstown. Meyersdale Area Education Association Staff Memorial Scholarship	\$500	The fund is established by the teachers of Meyersdale Area School District to benefit graduates that will continue their education in a college, university or technical school. This Scholarship is in memory of all staff members who gave their time and talent to educate the children of the Meyersdale Area School District.	
Meyersdale Church of the Brethren Kids' Klub Scholarship	2 @ \$500	Provides awards to past participants of the Meyersdale Church of the Brethren Kids' Klub who will be graduating and pursuing post-secondary education.	
Meyersdale Merit Scholarship	\$1,300	To award annual scholarship(s) to a Meyersdale Area High School Senior demonstrating academic potential, ability, and the intention to pursue his or her further education.

Michael P. Baer Memorial Scholarship Fund	\$250	To pay a \$250.00 scholarship to a senior annually upon graduation from the Meyersdale Area High School.	
Sheldon Bowman Memorial Scholarship	\$250	Supports graduating seniors from the Meyersdale School District who participate in the vocational agriculture program and who have been accepted to attend an accredited post-secondary educational institution with a scholarship award.	
Steve "Alf" Hahn Memorial Scholarship	\$400	Provides a scholarship to a graduating senior from Meyersdale Area High School who will be pursuing post-secondary education at an accredited college/university, business, or trade school. This scholarship shall be awarded to a student who is not eligible to receive another scholarship as administered by the high school or the Community Foundation (specifically for Meyersdale). Selection will be handled by donor working in conjunction with school district.	
William R. Lloyd, Jr. Scholarship	\$3,000 This scholarship is not exclusive to your students. Students from several other area school districts are eligible to apply and may be awarded the scholarship.	This scholarship award supports graduating seniors of Somerset County public high schools who intend to major in Government, Political Science, or Politics. The award has been endowed by former State Representative Bill Lloyd (D-Somerset) to encourage Somerset County students to pursue careers in public service. The scholarship will be paid out in the winner's sophomore year of college and is renewable for their junior and senior years if certain eligibility requirements are met.
