| J.L. Martin Scholarship | \$7,400 (paid out \$1,850 a year for 4 years) This scholarship is not exclusive to your students. Students from several other area school districts are eligible to apply and may be awarded the scholarship. | Supports a graduating senior of a Somerset County school district who has financial need and will likely succeed in their pursuit of post-secondary education. Your school district should provide included application to students fitting the criteria. Once all applications are submitted, school district scholarship committee should choose one top applicant. The top application, along with a recommendation letter from the school principal, should be submitted to CFA by deadline date. Applications from every school in Somerset County will be blind judged by a committee made up of at least five individuals. | April 15 |
| Joseph "Jack" Walker Award Scholarship | \$100 | Provides a scholarship to a graduating senior at Salisbury-Elk Lick High School that has been accepted into a post-secondary education program. The criteria for this scholarship are a GPA of 3.0 or higher, during their 4 years of high school. The recipient must be accepted into a post-secondary program. The candidate needs to have volunteered to do community service and present a one page recommendation letter from a person who supervised their community service. Also, the candidate must provide a recommendation letter from an adult, who is not a relative that will attest to the student's good moral character, strong positive attitude, and the respect they show for their life and the life of others. Kemerer Scholarship Fund | \$1,000 | Provides a scholarship to a graduating senior from Salisbury-Elk Lick High School who has been accepted to and will be attending an accredited post-secondary educational institution. Eligible applicants must have a GPA of at least 2.5 on a 4.0 scale their junior and senior years. General CFA application provided. Selection should be done by school district committee. | |
