Character and general citizenship will also be given consideration in this selection. The school district will make the selection for this award.	
J.L. Martin Scholarship	\$7,700 This scholarship is not exclusive to your students. Students from several other area school districts are eligible to apply and may be awarded the scholarship.	This scholarship was created to award outstanding students who are in need of financial assistance in order to obtain higher education and who will likely succeed in their schooling and make good future citizens. Students may be attending a college, university, or trade/technical school, and the scholarship is renewable up to four years. The school district will make the selection for this award.	
Leona Marian Scholarship Fund	\$1,000	Awarded to the Valedictorian. Check will be mailed after he/she completes one year of post-secondary education.	
Mary Samole Mawyer Scholarship	2 @ \$2,600 each	To be awarded to a graduating student(s) of the Conemaugh Township Area High School who has been accepted into an accredited two or four-year college and who demonstrates financial need. The school district will determine the number of scholarships to be awarded annually based on the fund's income and growth and will determine financial need based on accepted federal guidelines.	
McCready Family Scholarship Fund	\$2,500 This scholarship is not exclusive to your students. Steve and Hazel Terebus Fund	Two \$1,000 awards One male and one female recipient	The recipients of the Steven and Hazel Terebus scholarship should be: - A well-rounded student who exhibits excellence in their studies, athletics and, in their concern for others, community service. They may not necessarily be the top scholar, or the best athlete, but they should be dedicated and have come to their abilities through hard work. - Respected as a positive moral influence by his or her peers with the obvious ability to bring out the best in people. This interest should be carried over into the community with a commitment to serving others in area non-profit groups and/or their church or synagogue. Over a year's worth of meaningful service is a scholarship requirement. - An individual who works to the best of his or her ability and should maintain a minimum cumulative G.P.A. of 3.00 (B average) or better. With the foundation of an education with Conemaugh Township schools, they should be planning to further education through college or a two-year trade school. - A scholar/athlete with a minimum of two years participation in high school sports. - In the realms of his or her life, the candidate should be well rounded, with an avid interest in helping others. It is understood that annually a plaque will be given from the school district to the scholarship recipient that would include the phrase "The measure of a man is in the lives he's touched."	
William R. Lloyd, Jr. Scholarship	\$3,000 This scholarship is not exclusive to your students. Students from several other area school districts are eligible to apply and may be awarded the scholarship.	This scholarship award supports graduating seniors of Somerset County public high schools who intend to major in Government, Political Science, or Politics. The award has been endowed by former State Representative Bill Lloyd (D-Somerset) to encourage Somerset County students to pursue careers in public service. The scholarship will be paid out in the winner's sophomore year of college and is renewable for their junior and senior years if certain eligibility requirements are met.
