Ideal applicants must meet the following criteria:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Must either be a graduating senior of, or a past graduate of Ferndale or Conemaugh Valley High Schools • Attending a four-year post-secondary school • Must be a volunteer or employed person, who goes above and beyond their duties to improve the lives of others • Serve the community as a model or mentor • Fundraiser or charitable contributor that supports youth/senior programs, animal interests, or other local nonprofit organization • Demonstrates random acts of kindness <p>This award is given in memory of Olivia Catherine Red. Students from several other area school districts are eligible to apply and may be awarded the scholarship.</p>	<p>This fund was created in memory of Jim Janak, who excelled in sports. It recognizes outstanding high school athletes from Cambria County and supports their academic pursuits. Eligible applicants must have lettered in two high school sports, display a strong work ethic in their sports and classroom, demonstrate teamwork, loyalty and selflessness when dealing with others, and have a GPA of 3.2 or higher on a 4.0 scale.</p> <p>CFA ONLINE APPLICATION</p>	<p>Feb. 28</p>
<p>Johnson Family Scholarship</p>	<p>\$500</p>	<p>Provides an annual award to a graduating senior at Conemaugh Valley High School who plans to pursue post-secondary education at a trade, vocational, or technical school. This scholarship will be awarded to the applicant who best displays their motivation to succeed in their intended area of trade, vocational, or technical education. While a transcript is requested as a part of the application, the winner does not necessarily have to have the highest GPA. The award winner(s) will receive a full Cosmetology Student Kit and/or coverage of their License Fee. Students from several other area school districts are eligible to apply and	Students are eligible to be considered if they: - Has a parent, sibling or grandparent who has honorably served or is currently serving in any branch of the Armed Forces or he/she has signed a written obligation to serve in any branch of the military - Candidates will be judged on extracurricular school activities, community service, citizenship, participation in leadership programs such as Outdoor Odyssey, employment history and a mandatory essay. - Must provide proof that parent, sibling or grandparent has honorably served or is currently serving; if you are joining the military, please provide documentation of your written service obligation. Students from one other area school districts are eligible to apply and may be awarded the scholarship.</p>	<p>Provides a deserving African-American student with financial support during their first and second years of college. This award will honor students who excel in the classroom, model admirable leadership, and serve their community. Eligible applicants must have attained a cumulative high school GPA of at least 3.0 on an un-weighted scale and maintain a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or better during their first year of college. A personal statement of 750 words must be submitted, demonstrating the candidate's leadership abilities, community involvement, and service.</p> <p>\$1,000 for freshman year and \$1,000 for sophomore year if winner maintains a 3.0 GPA</p> <p>CFA ONLINE APPLICATION</p>	Feb. 28
