If so, this is the right scholarship for you.</p> <p>The Cambria County HWC Scholarship provides scholarship support for an individual residing in Cambria County who has been accepted to attend a post-secondary institution in Cambria County with the goal of receiving a certificate, associate's degree, or bachelor's degree and plans to enter into a human service field after graduation. This is open to both high school seniors and non-traditional students. Claudia Mehall Memorial Scholarship	\$500	<p>Eligible to Forest Hills High School seniors who have a minimum 3.0 GPA (out of a possible 4.0) and a strong history of community service and volunteer work. First preference is to award the scholarship to a student who will be majoring in the following fields that reflect the type of work that Claudia Mehall performed during her career at Forest Hills School District as the Supervisor of Special Education and School Psychologist: special education, psychology, social work, or a related field. If no students meet the field of study requirement, the scholarship should be awarded to the student whose community service and volunteer work most closely resemble the traits that Claudia displayed during her work: empathy, kindness, patience, and concern for others.</p> <p>Selection to be done by the Forest Hills scholarship committee using their knowledge of the senior class. The student should be pursuing a major in the educational field (elementary education, secondary education, special education, speech and hearing, or any other related education major) at an approved and accredited collegiate institution. If no students meet this requirement, then the scholarship can be awarded to a student pursuing a different major, as long as the rest of the following criteria are met. 2. The student should have a 3.3 or higher grade point average. 3. The student should participate in two or more varsity sports for a minimum of two years in each sport. 4. The student should display leadership abilities by being a captain or an officer in high school organizations. 5. The student must display teamwork, loyalty and selflessness while being a member of a team. 6. The student must display a strong work ethic in athletics and in the classroom. 7. Application provided. Selection determined by school district committee working in conjunction with donor.	
Walter E. Wood Scholarship	2 @ \$1,000	This provides a scholarship to one boy and one girl from a single parent home who are furthering their education through college, a trade or vocational school, or a personal enterprise.	
Wilfred, Jr. and Karen (Carter) Brandon Scholarship	\$2,000 This scholarship is not exclusive to your students. Students from one other area school districts are eligible to apply and may be awarded the scholarship.	Provides a deserving African-American student with financial support during their first and second years of college. This award will honor students who excel in the classroom, model admirable leadership, and serve their community. Eligible applicants must have attained a cumulative high school GPA of at least 3.0 on an un-weighted scale and maintain a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or better during their first year of college.
