		<p><b>Academic Alumni Scholarship</b> - provides scholarships to students who wish to further their education at a college, university, or trade/technical school. Students should be motivated to succeed and display involvement in extra-curricular and volunteer activities, but need not be the highest-performing academically to qualify. Award amounts vary, but typically makes multiple annual awards around \$2,000.</p> <p><b>Marie and Frank Slabe Scholarship</b> - provides a scholarship to graduating students of Johnstown High School who will attend a four-year liberal arts undergraduate college/university with the intention of attaining a bachelor of arts degree. This year's award will be \$2,700.</p> <p><b>Dan and Marcia Glosser Scholarship</b> - provides a \$1,000 scholarship to a student who exhibits excellence in studies and concern for others by their involvement in some form of community service. A prime requisite of the student is a good moral character, evidence by a positive moral influence on others. The student must be one who works to the best of his/her ability and maintains a B average or better. The student should be planning to further his/her education in a college, university, or a two-year trade school.</p> <p><b>Aaron Coyle Memorial Scholarship</b> - presented each year to a member of the Greater Johnstown High School graduating class in honor and remembrance of Aaron Coyle, a member of the graduating class of 2001, who was murdered one evening in Moxham before he could graduate. The award is presented to a senior whose life exemplifies the noblest of human values: faith, hope, love, and friendship, and in recognition of his or her willingness to give of one's time, energy, and talents to affirm the goodness of life.
