Andy Koma Memorial Registered Nurse Scholarship	\$700 each	This scholarship provides support to graduating seniors from West Shamokin, Indiana, Marion Center, and Apollo Ridge High Schools planning to attend an accredited post-secondary institution to pursue a registered nurse degree.	
ICTC Heidi Allison Character Award	Sizeable This scholarship is not exclusive to your students. Students from several other area school districts are eligible to apply and may be awarded the scholarship.	In memory of Heidi Allison, a health occupations instructor at Indiana County Technology Center who touched countless hearts and had an especially profound impact on her students. Heidi is remembered for nurturing young lives into adulthood through kindness, compassion, integrity and respect, exemplifying the foundational attributes that enhance student success in the classroom and beyond. Each year a graduating senior from ICTC will be given this award to recognize and affirm the importance of these basic character traits to a productive and fulfilling life, whether it involves advancing one's education, entering the workforce, or contributing to one's community.	
Indiana Co. Fire Chiefs Association Student Scholarship Award	2 @ \$500 each This scholarship is not exclusive to your students. Students from several other area school districts are eligible to apply and may be awarded the scholarship.	This scholarship was created to recognize and support students for community service. It is open to high school seniors or high school graduates pursuing post-secondary education at an accredited college/university, business or trade school. Ke-Ze Scholarship	\$4,000	In memory of two distinguished military officers, Betsy Kealey and Scott Zellem, this scholarship is awarded to a student who has at least a 3.0 GPA and possesses and exhibits leadership qualities and service to their school and community. Qualified applicants must be planning to serve in the military and attend a post-secondary educational institution after their service requirement is complete, attend a military academy, or participate in an ROTC program while attending a post-secondary educational institution. Myrtle and Walter Davis Scholarship	\$500	Provides an annual scholarship to a graduating senior from Indiana High School who plays golf and plans on attending Indiana University of Pennsylvania, with preference given to a female student.	
Salsgiver Family Scholarship	\$1,000	Provides annual scholarship support for a graduating senior at Indiana Area High School who has been accepted into a post-secondary institution to study an allied health or science-related field. Students should have a GPA of at least 3.0. School district selects this winner annually.	
Salvatore Agnello Scholarship	\$1,900	This scholarship provides support to a graduating senior at Indiana Area School District who wishes to further their education either by attending college, nurse training, or equivalent training.
