<b>NEW!</b> Bailey Family Football Matters Scholarship	\$500  This scholarship is not exclusive to your students. Students from other area school districts are eligible to apply and may be awarded the scholarship.	This scholarship supports one senior student annually who is currently enrolled in a Southern Alleghenies Football Coaches Association school and is a member of their high school football team. Applicants must also plan to be enrolled in college or trade school for the upcoming academic year and have a minimum GPA of 3.0 (B).  CFA ONLINE APPLICATION	<b>Feb. 28</b>
Dr. J.D. and Marianne Plummer and William Fennell Scholarship	\$1,000	Recipient must be a senior at Ligonier Valley High School who will be attending Seton Hill University. If no senior will be attending Seton Hill University, then the funds will not be distributed that year but will remain in the fund. Students to be considered should exhibit good values, strong community service, and display a caring and compassionate nature.	
Gloria (Madorma) Quigley Math Scholarship	\$350	The purpose of the Fund shall be to provide an annual scholarship of \$1,000 to a graduating senior from Ligonier Valley High School who intends to pursue a college degree in a major related to science, technology, engineering or math or math education. Applicants must have a minimum cumulative grade point average of 3.5, and have completed and excelled in upper level math classes, such as Calculus and Statistics.	
Indiana Co. Fire Chiefs Association Student Scholarship Award	2 @ \$500 each  This scholarship is not exclusive to your students. Students from several other area school districts are eligible to apply and may be awarded the scholarship.	This scholarship was created to recognize and support students for community service. It is open to high school seniors or high school graduates pursuing post-secondary education at an accredited college/university, business or trade school. Collegiate freshmen, sophomores, and juniors are eligible to apply, as well as non-traditional students who will be re-entering school in the upcoming semester.  CFA ONLINE APPLICATION	<b>Feb. 28</b>
Nicholas Enos Memorial Scholarship	Two \$4,000 awards (paid out \$1,000 a year for 4 years)	The recipients will be a male and female senior student in good academic standing who exhibit leadership abilities, display respect and unwavering kindness toward others regardless of age, are involved in community activities, display athletic skills and are pursuing higher education after graduation.
