Doyle E. Paul Memorial Scholarship	\$1,000 This scholarship is not exclusive to your students. Students from several other area school districts are eligible to apply and may be awarded the scholarship.	Created in memory of Doyle Paul, who was devoted to promoting the agriculture Industry in Somerset County and on a state and national level. Eligible applicants must be graduating from a school district located in Somerset County and be a member of the Pennsylvania FFA Association. They also must be planning to pursue post-secondary education or training directly related to the practice of agriculture or agribusiness at an accredited post-secondary college, university or technical school in the upcoming fall semester. J.L. Martin Scholarship	\$7,700 This scholarship is not exclusive to your students. Students from several other area school districts are eligible to apply and may be awarded the scholarship.	This scholarship was created to award outstanding students who are in need of financial assistance in order to obtain higher education and who will likely succeed in their schooling and make good future citizens. Students may be attending a college, university, or trade/technical school, and the scholarship is renewable up to four years. Eligible applicants must have resided in and attended high school in Somerset County continuously over the last four years. CFA ONLINE APPLICATION	Feb. 28
Joseph "Jack" Walker Award Scholarship	\$100	Provides a scholarship to a graduating senior at Salisbury-Elk Lick High School that has been accepted into a post-secondary education program. The criteria for this scholarship are a GPA of 3.0 or higher, during their 4 years of high school. The recipient must be accepted into a post-secondary program. The candidate needs to have volunteered to do community service and present a one page recommendation letter from a person who supervised their community service. Also, the candidate must provide a recommendation letter from an adult, who is not a relative that will attest to the student's good moral character, strong positive attitude, and the respect they show for their life and the life of others. Kemerer Scholarship Fund	\$1,000	Provides a scholarship to a graduating senior from Salisbury-Elk Lick High School who has been accepted to and will be attending an accredited post-secondary educational institution. Eligible applicants must have a GPA of at least 2.5 on a 4.0 scale their junior and senior years. Selection should be done by school district committee.	
Robert Broadwater Literary Award	\$150	Robert Broadwater Literary Award Provides an award for a senior at Salisbury-Elk Lick High School that demonstrates an exceptional aptitude for writing or one who has exhibited actual talent and skill at writing or journalism. The ideal candidate would be one who is planning to continue their education in the field of journalism, creative writing, or some other writing major. While continued education in the field is desirable, it should not be held above raw talent as a condition for bestowing the award. Passion and aptitude are the most important qualities. The award shall be open to all forms and genres of writing. Selection to be handled by school district committee.	
William R. Lloyd, Jr. Scholarship	\$3,000 This scholarship is not exclusive to your students. Students from several other area school districts are eligible to apply and may be awarded the scholarship.	This scholarship award supports graduating seniors of Somerset County public high schools who intend to major in Government, Political Science, or Politics. The award has been endowed by former State Representative Bill Lloyd (D-Somerset) to encourage Somerset County students to pursue careers in public service. The scholarship will be paid out in the winner's sophomore year of college and is renewable for their junior and senior years if certain eligibility requirements are met.
