Griffith Memorial Scholarship	Two \$1,500 awards	<p>In selecting a recipient of the first scholarship, the following shall be considered:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The student must be entering a post-secondary institution pursuing a degree in a business related field • Must possess an overall GPA of 3.0 • Must submit a resume • Must submit two teacher recommendations • Must submit a one-page essay on the topic of "The Importance of Work Ethic" <p>In selecting a recipient of the second scholarship, the following shall be considered:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Applicant must be entering a post-secondary institution pursuing a technical degree. Students pursuing an associate, diploma, or certificate degree are urged to apply. A few examples of technical degrees include computer technology, emergency medical technician, HVAC, industrial technology, and machining technology. • Applicant must possess an overall GPA of 80+ • Applicant must submit a one-page essay "My Career Goal." Be certain your essay includes your career goal, your reason for choosing this career, and what you have done to prepare for a career in this field. • Applicant must complete the standard scholarship application 	
Glen George Memorial Scholarship	\$250	<p>Created to support a graduating senior at United School District who plans to pursue a career in the field of science, technology, or science education.</p> <p>Students must complete the standard scholarship application and submit a 1-2 paragraph essay describing their career goals. Recipient to be selected by the Glen George family members in conjunction with the school district scholarship committee.</p>	
Hoover Family Scholarship	\$500	To provide a scholarship to a United Basketball player.	
Indiana Co. Fire Chiefs Association Student Scholarship Award	<p>2 @ \$500 each</p> <p>This scholarship is not exclusive to your students. Students from several other area school districts are eligible to apply.</p>	<p>This scholarship was created to recognize and support students for community service. It is open to high school seniors or high school graduates pursuing post-secondary education at an accredited college/university, business or trade school. Ke-Ze Scholarship	\$4,000	In memory of two distinguished military officers, Betsy Kealey and Scott Zellem, this scholarship is awarded to a student who has at least a 3.0 GPA and possesses and exhibits leadership qualities and service to their school and community. Qualified applicants must be planning to serve in the military and attend a post-secondary educational institution after their service requirement is complete, attend a military academy, or participate in an ROTC program while attending a post-secondary educational institution. Laura Uadiski Wright Memorial Scholarship	\$1,000	Created to provide a \$1,000 scholarship to graduating seniors at United School District who are planning to pursue post-secondary education in a healthcare field. Students must complete standard application and submit an essay on why they are choosing a career in healthcare and what winning the scholarship would mean to them financially. Winner will be selected by committee chosen by fund representative.	
McCully Scholarship	United School District will advise the Community Foundation if funds are available	Essay focused, student must write on how they've personally demonstrated resiliency.	
Shawn Carota Football Scholarship Fund	\$250	The purpose of this scholarship is to help a Senior football player from United High School with a scholarship to honor the memory and giving personality of Shawn.	
United High School Student Council Scholarship	United School District will advise the Community Foundation if funds are available	Criteria established by donor.	
United School District Scholarship	United School District will advise the Community Foundation if funds are available	To benefit graduates pursuing education at a college, university, vocational/technical school or apprenticeship program. <u>Eligibility:</u> The scholarship grants shall be made to one or more students who have demonstrated academic excellence by attaining not less than the equivalent of a B or 3.0 cumulative average at their level of education and who wish to pursue post-high school education in a college, graduate school, vocational and/or technical school or apprenticeship program accredited by a state and/or national accrediting body. <u>Selection Procedure:</u> Recipients of scholarship grants shall be selected by a Scholarship Selection Committee which shall consist of at least five (5) members, but not more than seven (7). The United School District Superintendent shall appoint one member from each of the following groups: the United School District faculty, administration, and guidance department; and shall appoint additional members who may be residents or non-residents of the United School District.
