This scholarship award supports graduating seniors of Somerset County public high schools who intend to major in Government, Political Science, or Politics. The award has been endowed by former State Representative Bill Lloyd (D-Somerset) to encourage Somerset County students to pursue careers in public service. The scholarship will be paid out in the winner's sophomore year of college and is renewable for their junior and senior years if certain eligibility requirements are met. Walter Mahler Memorial Scholarship	\$1,100	The criteria for the scholarship are as follows: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Must be a graduating senior of Shade-Central City High School who is accepted at and planning to attend a 4-year accredited college. (Non-accredited colleges will be considered, provided they are well-known, well-established, and have a good reputation.) - Must demonstrate good grades and SAT scores, and be in the top third of their class. - Community service, community activities, church activities and extracurricular school activities will be greatly considered in the decision. - To apply, students should submit: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> a) a letter of application b) a resume of activities and awards c) a paragraph answering the question "Why did you choose your field of study, and how do you hope to use it to contribute to society?" d) two recommendations: one from a teacher, and one from a person outside the school, such as a community leader, church leader or employer - In the event Shade High School becomes part of a larger school district, first preference will be given to students residing in Shade Township or Central City Borough. - Scholarship winner(s) will be determined by the Shade-Central City School District.
