Submission Process Checklist

Important Notes

-Eligible entrepreneurs must engage a Region 12 Referral Partner in at least one consultation regarding a business formation or development activity.

-Referral Partners must determine the appropriateness of a referral to the CEA Program using the referral criteria.

-Referral of a creative entrepreneur to CFA does not guarantee that a grant award will be made; CFA will make final determinations based on eligibility and availability of funds.
