Bailey Family Football Matters Scholarship	\$500	This scholarship supports one senior student annually who is currently enrolled in a Southern Alleghenies Football Coaches Association school and is a member of their high school football team. Applicants must also plan to be enrolled in college or trade school for the upcoming academic year and have minimum GPA of 3.0 (B).
Bedford Grange Mutual Scholarship	Dependent on the number of qualified students. Last year's awards were \$1,400 each.	Provides awards to children of Bedford Grange Mutual Insurance company policy-holders. The application is open to high school seniors who plan to attend a college, university, or trade/technical school in the fall, as well as collegiate freshmen, sophomores, and juniors. Applicants must show a strong history of community service and extra-curricular involvement, and demonstrate that they are motivated to achieve their goals.
Jeff Dull Memorial Scholarship	Donor decides annually. Last year's awards were \$1,000 each.	This scholarship is for graduating Bedford High School seniors who will be attending a post-secondary school who have a strong sense of community. This award was created in memory of Jeff Dull, a 1986 graduate of Bedford High School.
McCready Family Scholarship	\$2,700	Provides a scholarship award to a high school graduate from Cambria, Somerset, or Bedford County who plans to pursue an academic degree relating to communications, journalism, or English at the University of Pittsburgh at Johnstown.
Mr. Jodon Educational Scholarship 2024	\$400	Provides a scholarship for students in Bedford, Cambria, Indiana, Somerset, or Westmoreland counties who will be pursuing a post-secondary degree in education.
Pat and Paul Detwiler Family Scholarship Fund	2 at \$2,500	To provide scholarship support for two scholarship awards per year. One scholarship/monetary gift will be given to a Bedford County Career and Technical Center (BCCTC) student. This may be a monetary gift or scholarship. The student can be from any of the sending schools to BCCTC. The second scholarship will be for a Bedford High School student who is continuing his/her education at a post high school/university. The recipient(s) must be entering the field of business or some type of entrepreneurial business start-up.

Camp PARC Helping Hand Scholarship	\$1,000	Applicants must have served as a Junior Counselor, Peer Buddy, Childcare Counselor, Resident Staff Assistant, or a combination of those positions for a minimum of two years for the full duration of any of the camping sessions at Camp PARC in addition to or including the summer in which they apply for the scholarship. - Purpose:
  - Scholarships in the amount of \$8,000 (maximum) annually for up to four (4) years will be awarded to selected applicant(s).
  - The scholarships awarded are determined annually based on the projected employment needs of UPMC Bedford.
- Qualifications: The following qualifications are necessary for scholarship consideration:
  - Resident of Bedford County (minimum one-year full-time residency)
  - Notification of acceptance into an actual health professions program of study. Pre-program (i.e. Pre Medicine, Pre Pharmacy, Pre Physical Therapy), undeclared, and division of undergraduate studies acceptance do not qualify. (Students may apply any year during their course of study.)
  - Verification of financial need
  - Two (2) letters of recommendation from high school teacher, post-secondary faculty or employer. Current college or university students must submit at least one of the two (2) letters of recommendation from a college/university faculty member.
