Huston Township Alumni Association Scholarships	Huston Township Alumni Association determines award amounts annually	The Huston Township Alumni Association awards two scholarships annually: The Huston Township Alumni Association Scholarship and the Warry H. and Mary E. Shoemaker Scholarship. Both awards are available to graduating seniors who live in Huston Township. Consideration will be given to academics, extra-curriculars, community service, and college entrance exam scores. The Huston Township Alumni Association Scholarship is to be paid after the successful completion of the student's first semester of college, typically in January. The Warry H. and Mary E. Shoemaker Scholarship is paid with no restrictions.
