| Bailey Family Football Matters Scholarship | \$500 | Provides scholarship support to a senior student who is currently enrolled in a Southern Alleghenies Football Coaches Association school and is a member of their high school football team. |
| Baskin Foundation Scholarship | Fund rep decides annually | The Baskin Foundation was designed to award scholarships for higher education to students who have attended a high school located in Indiana County and are planning to pursue a degree in nursing or physical education and have a demonstrated history of academic achievement. The foundation was created in 1996 in memory of Anna Mae Sweeny Baskin and Graham Sefton Baskin. |
| Elmer C. Laslo Memorial Scholarship | \$1,000 | Provides scholarship support for students pursuing a business-related field at a post- secondary educational institution. Eligible applicants must attend a high school located within the 1st Summit Bank market area. |
| Mr. Jodon Educational Scholarship | \$400 | Provides a scholarship for students in Bedford, Cambria, Indiana, Somerset, or Westmoreland counties who will be pursuing a post-secondary degree in education. |
| Scott A. Salser Memorial Scholarship | \$600 | Provides an annual scholarship to a student who lives in Indiana County who is planning to study at the post-secondary level in fields related to music and vocal performance, including education. |
