Baskin Foundation Scholarship	Fund rep decides annually	The Baskin Foundation was designed to award scholarships for higher education to students who have attended a high school located in Indiana County and are planning to pursue a degree in nursing or physical education and have a demonstrated history of academic achievement. The foundation was created in 1996 in memory of Anna Mae Sweeny Baskin and Graham Sefton Baskin.
Elmer C. Laslo Memorial Scholarship	\$1,000	Provides scholarship support for students pursuing a business-related field at a post-secondary educational institution. Eligible applicants must attend a high school located within the 1st Summit Bank market area.
Mr. Jodon Educational Scholarship	\$400	Provides a scholarship for students in Bedford, Cambria, Indiana, Somerset, or Westmoreland counties who will be pursuing a post-secondary degree in education.
Scott A. Salser Memorial Scholarship	\$600	Provides an annual scholarship to a student who lives in Indiana County who is planning to study at the post-secondary level in fields related to music and vocal performance, including education.

Bernie McQuown Memorial Scholarship	\$1,100	This scholarship is awarded to a senior football player at Indiana Area High School who has demonstrated a history of academic achievement and strong morals. Eligible candidates must be pursuing post-secondary education at any accredited school, be a high-achieving student who has earned a cumulative grade of 85% or higher, and have contributed to their school and/or community through volunteerism and extracurriculars.  Please note that this scholarship is awarded at the fall sports banquet and not the spring senior awards ceremony, so the winner must be selected early.
Myrtle and Walter Davis Scholarship	\$500	Provides an annual scholarship to a graduating senior from Indiana High School who plays golf and plans on attending Indiana University of Pennsylvania, with preference given to a female student.
Mark Hess Legacy Scholarship	\$1,500	Provides scholarships for students of the Indiana School District.
Salsgiver Family Scholarship	\$2,000	Provides an annual scholarship for a graduating senior at Indiana Area High School who has been accepted into a post-secondary institution to study an allied health or science-related field. Students should have a GPA of at least 3.0. School district selects this winner annually.
Salvatore Agnello Scholarship	\$2,100	This scholarship provides support to a graduating senior at Indiana Area School District who wishes to further their education either by attending college, nurse training, or equivalent training.

ICTC Heidi Allison Character Award	\$10,000	In memory of Heidi Allison, a health occupations instructor at Indiana County Technology Center who touched countless hearts and had an especially profound impact on her students. Heidi is remembered for nurturing young lives into adulthood through kindness, compassion, integrity and respect, exemplifying the foundational attributes that enhance student success in the classroom and beyond. Each year a graduating senior from ICTC will be given this award to recognize and affirm the importance of these basic character traits to a productive and fulfilling life, whether it involves advancing one's education, entering the workforce, or contributing to one's community.
