Award Name	Amount	Description
Bailey Family Football Matters Scholarship	\$500	This scholarship supports one senior student annually who is currently enrolled in a Southern Alleghenies Football Coaches Association school and is a member of their high school football team. Applicants must also plan to be enrolled in college or trade school for the upcoming academic year and have minimum GPA of 3.0 (B).
Elmer C. Laslo Memorial Scholarship	\$1,000	Provides scholarship support for students pursuing a business-related field at a post-secondary educational institution. Eligible applicants must attend a high school located within the 1st Summit Bank market area.
Mr. Jodon Educational Scholarship	\$400	Provides a scholarship for students in Bedford, Cambria, Indiana, Somerset, or Westmoreland counties who will be pursuing a post-secondary degree in education.
Staff Sergeant Alvin P. Carey and Private John C. Ewing Medal of Honor Scholarship	We expect to provide at least one \$1,000 award at each school	The Staff Sergeant Alvin P. Carey Memorial Scholarship provides scholarship support for Ligonier Valley High School seniors who either have made a commitment to serve in the military or have a family member who is serving or has honorably served in the military. This award was created to honor Sgt. Carey, a Ligonier graduate and Medal of Honor winner who was killed in action during World War II.

Award Name	Amount	Description
Dr. JD and Marianne Plummer and William Fennell Scholarship	\$1,000	Recipient must be a senior at Ligonier Valley High School who will be attending Seton Hill University. If no senior will be attending Seton Hill University, then the funds will not be distributed that year but will remain in the fund. Students to be considered should exhibit good values, strong community service, and display a caring and compassionate nature.
Gloria (Madorma) Quigley Memorial Math Scholarship	\$1,000	Provides an annual scholarship to a graduating senior from Ligonier Valley High School who intends to pursue a college degree in a major related to science, technology, engineering or math or math education. Applicants must have a minimum cumulative grade point average of 3.5, and have completed and excelled in upper-level math classes, such as Calculus and Statistics.
Nicholas Enos Memorial Scholarship	2 at \$4,000 each	Provides a 4-year \$1,000 scholarship for two seniors at Ligonier Valley High School who are good students, exhibit leadership, and display respect and kindness toward others regardless of age. Students must be involved in community activities, demonstrate athletic skills, and intend to pursue higher education

Indiana County Fire Chiefs Association Student Scholarship Award	2 @ \$500 each	This scholarship was created to recognize and support students for community service. It is open to high school seniors or graduates pursuing post-secondary education at an accredited college or university, business, or trade school. Collegiate freshman, sophomores, and juniors are eligible to apply, as well as non-traditional students who will be re-entering school in the upcoming semester. Students must live within the service area of an Indiana County Fire Department. This is an online application and will be available at cfalleghenies.org/scholarships starting in December.
