To apply, students should submit: a) a letter of application b) a resume of activities and awards c) a paragraph answering the question "Why did you choose your field of study, and how do you hope to use it to contribute to society?" d) two recommendations: one from a teacher, and one from a person outside the school, such as a community leader, church leader or employer In the event Shade High School becomes part of a larger school district, first preference will be given to students residing in Shade Township or Central City Borough. Scholarship winner(s) will be determined by the Shade-Central City School District. |
