Amy Gresh eaRNed Scholarship Established in Memory of Erma Gresh  (New)	\$4,000 over four years	The Amy Gresh eaRNed Scholarship was created to inspire local students by providing support for post-secondary nursing education. Eligible students will be graduating seniors of Bishop McCort Catholic High School, Greater Johnstown High School, Ferndale, Windber, Conemaugh Valley, Westmont Hilltop, or Richland who have financial need. Scholarship winners have the potential to receive four years of funding, so long as they continue to make satisfactory progress toward graduating from a nursing program. This is a \$4,000 award which will be distributed as four annual \$1,000 payments.
Andy's Army Scholarship, in honor of the Rocky Mountain Regional VA Medical Center Nursing Staff	\$1,000	Provides scholarship support for a graduating senior student attending a high school within Cambria or Somerset County who has been accepted to a post-secondary educational institution to study nursing.
Bailey Family Football Matters Scholarship	\$500	This scholarship supports one senior student annually who is currently enrolled in a Southern Alleghenies Football Coaches Association school and is a member of their high school football team. Applicants must also plan to be enrolled in college or trade school for the upcoming academic year and have minimum GPA of 3.0 (B).
Children are Precious - Johnstown Walk of Hope Scholarship	Fund rep decides annually	Provides scholarships for students who have a cancer diagnosis or are a cancer survivor or who have been impacted by a cancer diagnosis of a parent or caregiver.
Doyle E. Paul Memorial Scholarship	\$1,000	Created in memory of Doyle Paul, who was devoted to promoting the agriculture Industry in Somerset County and on a state and national level.  Eligible applicants must be graduating from a school district located in Somerset County and be a member of the Pennsylvania FFA Association. They also must be planning to pursue post-secondary education or training directly related to the practice of agriculture or agribusiness at an accredited post-secondary college, university or technical school in the upcoming fall semester. The scholarship will be paid out in the winner's first year of college.

Dr. Brad Puckey Memorial Scholarship	\$500	Provides scholarship support for students who have graduated from a high school in Cambria or Somerset counties, have military experience, and area pursuing post-secondary education in an economics or business major.
Eastern Elevator-Irene Westover Memorial Scholarship	\$2,500 each	The Eastern Elevator Irene Westover Memorial Scholarship Fund is named in honor of Eastern Elevator's Founding Mother, Irene Westover. Irene was forced to end her education at the age of 11 or 12 to help her mother raise her younger siblings upon the accidental death of her father. Irene proceeded to raise eight children whom she nurtured through their educational years.  This scholarship is available to relatives of full-time Eastern Elevator employees who wish to continue their education. Eligible applicants must be accepted into a post-secondary program and will attend a two- or four-year accredited institution of higher learning or a recognized and accredited trade school. Students may be traditional or non-traditional, full- or part-time, and be in any year of their education progress.
Elmer C. Laslo Memorial Scholarship	\$1,000	Provides scholarship support for students pursuing a business-related field at a post-secondary educational institution. Eligible applicants must attend a high school located within the 1st Summit Bank market area.

Eligible students will be graduating from high school this academic year and planning to attend a post-secondary institution after graduation.
J.L. Martin Scholarship	\$8,100	This scholarship was created to award outstanding students who are in need of financial assistance in order to obtain higher education and who will likely succeed in their schooling and make good future citizens. Students may be attending a college, university, or trade/technical school, and the scholarship is renewable up to four years. Eligible applicants must have resided in and attended high school in Somerset County continuously over the last four years.

McCready Family Scholarship Fund	\$2,700	Provides a scholarship award to a high school graduate from Cambria, Somerset or Bedford County who plans to pursue an academic degree relating to communications, journalism, or English at the University of Pittsburgh at Johnstown.
Mr. Jodon Educational Scholarship	\$400	Provides a scholarship for students in Bedford, Cambria, Indiana, Somerset, or Westmoreland counties who will be pursuing a post-secondary degree in education.

The scholarship will be paid out in the winner's sophomore year of college and is renewable for their junior and senior years if certain eligibility requirements are met.
